The Memphis Board of Education last night awarded a \$14,900 contract to Biggs Wrecking Co. for demolition of the last remaining original building on the Messick High School campus, built in 1908, plus small additions built in 1935 and 1951. Plans for the demolition were revealed several weeks ago. The Biggs offer was the lowest of five bids received. The contract was approved among routine business items without discussion. Representatives of the Messick-Buntyn Neighborhood Association have asked that they be allowed to participate in future decisions relating to the Messick campus. Messick was closed as a high school in 1981. The campus has a new vocational center and is now being used as a vocational and adult training center.
